

Chaparral High School Graduation Timeline Information 2008

Chaparral's Graduation ceremony is scheduled for **Wednesday, May 28, 2008, at 8:00 p.m.**, in our football stadium. A timeline of events is listed below for your reference. All requirements/financial obligations (**i.e. grades, credits, test compliances, fees, return of library and textbooks**) need to be completed or you will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony. Diplomas will be issued to you after all the requirements for graduation have been met. Information regarding the actual ceremony will be given to you May 12-16 during Government or Economics classes. If you are a graduating 11th grader, a mid-term graduate, attend Vo-Tech/EVIT during the mornings, or any other "special situations" yet wish to go through the graduation ceremony, please see Mrs. Clark (or call 480-484-6517) in the Educational Services office as soon as possible so that we can be sure you are on the graduation and diploma list. Be sure to listen for daily announcements prior to graduation regarding the upcoming ceremony details. Students do not need to attend the graduation ticket meetings.

May 6 and May 7—Parent Meetings for Graduation Tickets:

Please note that ALL graduating students' financial obligations must be taken care of prior to picking up tickets.

Graduates need to take care of the following tasks:

- Order and pick up cap, gown, and announcements (Dispersed to students April 4th at Chaparral)
 - Josten's is the vendor (602-765-7227 if you still need to order a cap and gown).
 - Pre-ordered caps and gowns are still available for pickup in the bookstore.
- Verify with your counselor that all graduation requirements have been met.
- Complete all requirements for correspondence courses *including* final exams by May 9, 2008.
- Complete all requirements for Pinnacle On-line classes by May 15th.
- Order final transcript after graduation from www.docufide.com
 - Request that Docufide send transcripts to the college you plan to attend.
- Request an official transcript be sent to the CHS Recorder for those taking Dual Credit classes.
- Pay all outstanding debts prior graduation meetings.

May 12 through 16:

Mrs. Muccino and Mrs. Holland will be visiting Government and Economics classes to speak to seniors regarding the graduation process and ceremony during this week. If you are not enrolled in a Government or Economics class now, please make arrangements with Mrs. Holland to get this information.

May 22:

The graduation ceremony is scheduled for 8:00 p.m. in the Chaparral Football Stadium. Students report to their assigned room at 7:00 p.m. Room assignments will be posted upstairs in the 200 building and in the main office on the day of the ceremony. The stadium will open for parent and visitor admission at 6:45 p.m. Admission is by ticket only.

Diplomas will be handed out at the end of graduation night if you attend Project Graduation. Otherwise, you may pick up your diploma on May 29 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, or anytime during the school's summer hours. **Diplomas are a legal document and will NOT be mailed to you!**

**May 28th is the last day to clean out lockers!
Remaining items will be collected and discarded or donated when school is out.**

All fees must be paid and all textbooks returned to your teachers.
